

Notice of Additional Child Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (50,000 Yen per Child)

- The Additional Child Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (50,000 Yen per Child) for Households Exempt from Resident Tax, Etc. for Fiscal Year 2023 is a special benefit extended to households exempt from resident tax, etc. that utilizes the government's Temporary Special Grant for Local Governments to Tackle the Rising Price of Goods.
- **Procedures are required in certain cases** to receive this benefit.

Amount of Benefit Payment

50,000 yen per child 18 years old or younger* (Provided on a per-household basis)

* Children born on or after April 2, 2005

Eligibility and Procedures for the Benefit

Eligible Households

Households eligible for the Suginami City Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (70,000 Yen or 100,000 Yen)* that include dependent children 18 years old or younger

* Households with a residence registration in Suginami City as of December 1, 2023 (Base Eligibility Date) that meet the following requirements

[70,000 yen benefit] Households in which all members of the household are exempt from the per capita resident tax for fiscal year 2023

[100,000 yen benefit] Households in which all members are subject to per capita resident tax only for fiscal year 2023, or households that include both members who are subject to per capita resident tax only and members who are exempt from per capita resident tax for fiscal year 2023

1 Eligible households that received the Suginami City Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (70,000 Yen or 100,000 Yen) for Fiscal Year 2023 **in the head of household's account**

No procedures required (in principle)

2 Eligible households that received the Suginami City Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (70,000 Yen or 100,000 Yen) for Fiscal Year 2023 **in an account other than the head of household's account**

Submission of confirmation form required

See ② on the back side of this document

3 Separate application procedures required for eligible households in the following situations

- Households with **children born on or after December 2, 2023**
- Households that **provide the livelihood of a child 18 years old or younger living in a separate household** (dormitory, etc.)
- Households with **dependents (for tax purposes) 18 years old or younger living in a separate household**
- **Divorced households** or **households separated on the premise of divorce on or after December 1, 2023***

Procedure / Payment Period

Applicable households under **1** on front page



- A **Notice of Provision** will be sent to the heads of relevant households in stages.
- The benefit will be transferred to the **account** used to receive the Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (70,000 Yen or 100,000 Yen) for Fiscal Year 2023.

Applicable households under **2** on front page



- **Documents including a Confirmation Form** will be sent in stages to the heads of relevant households.
- Complete the confirmation form, attach the required documents (such as a photocopy of the passbook verifying the account to which the benefit will be transferred) as indicated in the enclosed notice, and return them.

Application Deadline

**Friday, May 31, 2024
(must be postmarked by this date)**

Payment will be made about one month after the submission of your documents.

Applicable households under **3** on front page

For eligible households with children born on or after December 2, 2023

Q

I am the head of a household that has already received the Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (70,000 yen) for Fiscal Year 2023. My household includes children aged 5 years old and 3 years old as of the Base Eligibility Date (December 1, 2023). My household also includes a child born on December 2, 2023. What should I do to receive the Additional Child Benefit?

A

Information on the payment date for the Additional Child Benefit for registered residents 18 years old or younger as of the Base Eligibility Date (December 1, 2023) will be included in the Notice of Provision. No further action is required to receive the benefit amount (100,000 yen) for the 5-year-old child and 3-year-old child. However, for the Additional Child Benefit (50,000 Yen) for the child born on December 2, 2023, you will be required to submit the Application (Payment Request) Form for Suginami City Support Benefit for Rising Prices of Goods (Additional Child Benefit). See the procedure for ③ above. Note that applications must be submitted by May 31, 2024, or the benefit will be forfeited.
