Raise and Foster Awareness of Mutual Respect

Aim to create a community where people can build close-knit relationships with each other and where all people can play an active role through social participation.

Priority Subject

Preparation of Bases for Intercultural Cohesion

Establish a base where people of different cultures and backgrounds can gather, providing services such as Japanese language study support and daily life consultation services for foreign residents, as well as exchange events, with the purpose of community participation.
